### What To Bring To Purchase A Vehicle

- Proof of Insurance:** In Florida, all drivers must carry proof of insurance whenever they're behind the wheel. - Proof of Income:** If you're planning on getting a loan through Gettel Automotive, bring a few of your most recent pay stubs. Showing proof of employment is crucial when applying for an auto loan.
- Preferred Form of Payment:** Whether you decide a loan, check, or cash is your preferred form of payment, you'll want to have it ready. Plan to have your down payment with you when you walk in. and if you plan to finance through the dealership, make sure to set aside some time to fill out the necessary paperwork.

- Discount Information:** If you receive a discount from the dealership, manufacturer, or your credit card company, you'll need to provide accurate documentation to take advantage of it.

### What To Bring To Trade In Your Vehicle

- Title and Registration:** This documentation is important when proving that the car you want to trade in is actually yours. If you're having trouble locating the original title, you can get a copy from your DMV. Even if your registration has expired, it should still be eligible.
- Service Records:** You can increase the trade-in value of your vehicle by providing proper documentation of all service and maintenance performed.
- All Sets of Keys:** Bring all the keys you have for your vehicle.
